# Holy Week Reading Plan: Jesus, Savior and King

# Palm Sunday

**Read**: Triumphal Entry (Mt 21:1-9, Mk 11:1-10, Lk 19:28-40, Jn 12:12-19)

Reflect on Jesus as King. What does that mean practically in your life today?

**Read:** Jesus weeps over Jerusalem (Lk 19:41-44)

**Reflect** on Jesus' great love for us as his children. How is that important for you today?

**Read**: Jesus cleanses the temple (Mt 21:10-16, Lk 19:45-46)

**Reflect** on how Jesus feels about corruption of the gospel/temple. How do you abide in truth in your everyday life?

**Read:** Jesus sleeps at Bethany (Mk 11:11, Mt 21:17) **Reflect** on rest as a necessary part of ministry and life. Is there a special call for rest in your life during this season?

**Read**: Jesus is Anointed in Bethany (Jn 12:1-8) **Reflect** on Jesus accepting our proper worship. How can you maintain a right posture in your worship this week?

## Monday

**Read**: Jesus curses the fig tree (Mt 21:18-19, Mk 11:12-14)

**Reflect** on the importance of bearing fruit in the life of the believer. Where is your faith currently bearing fruit?

**Read:** Second cleansing of temple (Mk 11:15-17, Lk 19:45-46)

**Reflect** on the importance of the 'temple' in Christianity (the believers heart). Ask God to root out anything offensive in your temple today.

## Tuesday

#### Read: The fig tree (Mk 11:20-26)

**Reflect** on the withering up of a life not bearing fruit by abiding in Christ. Pray for yourself, a friend, or loved one experiencing a withering season. **Read:** Jesus' authority questioned (Mk 11:27-33, Lk 20:1-8)

**Reflect** on who has authority in your life. Ask for forgiveness in the areas not submitted to Christ. **Read**: Temple teaching: the parable of wedding dinner: (Mt 22:1-14)

**Reflect** on who is invited to the wedding feast. Pray for any who would turn down the invitation.

# Wednesday

Read: Temple teachings: Resurrection (Mt 22:23-33, Lk 20:27-40) The Great Commandment (Mt 22:34-40, Mk 12:28-34), About Scribes and Pharisees (Mt 23:1-36)
Reflect on how Christ asks us to show our love for Him. Is there any place in your life that you are acting on rules more than your love of Christ?
Read: Jesus teaches on Mt. Olivet: Destruction of the Temple (Mt 24:1-2, Mk 13:1-2, Lk 21:5-6), Persecution (Mk 13:9-13), The lesson of the fig tree (Mk 13:28-32, Lk 21:29-33)
Reflect on Jesus's promise for His future return. If you believe these truths, how do you live each day on Earth recognizing the gift He has given you?

# Thursday

Read: Preparation for the passover (Mt 26:17-20, Mk 14:12-17, Lk 22:7-14), Jesus washes the feet of his disciples (Jn 13:1-20) **Reflect** on the Lord's actions. Pray for humility to serve those you love. **Read:** Jesus fortells the betraval (Jn 13:21-30), The Last Supper (Mt 26:26-29, Mk 14:22-25, Lk 22:15-20), Jesus teaches on discipleship (Lk 22: 24-30) Reflect on biblical friendship, loyalty, and 'greatness.' Read: The Commandment of Love (Jn 13:31-35) Reflect on the new commandment given by Jesus. How will people know you are a disciple of Jesus? Read: Jesus in Gethsemane (Mt 26:36-46, Mk 14:32-42. Lk 22:39-46) Reflect on the actions of Jesus. How do you pray to the Father? Read: Jesus is Arrested (Mt 26:47-56, Mk 14:43-52, Lk 22:47-53, Jn 18:2-12) **Reflect** on Christ as the fulfillment. How does this strengthen your faith when you are going through suffering?

## Friday

**Read:** Jesus before the Sanhedrin, Peter's Denial (Mt 26:57-68), Jesus delivered to Pilate, Death of Judas (Mt 27:1-14), Jesus before Herod (Lk 23:6-12), Pilate declares Jesus innocent, offers a choice (Jn 18:39-19:15), Pilate delivers Jesus to be Crucified (Jn 19:16)
